The agency was founded in response to the 2002 Queensland State Tourist Development Strategy which called for a 50% increase in international visitor numbers to Queensland by 2012/13. The agency is responsible for managing the Tourism Act 1997. It is charged with promoting the state's tourism offering, for example through marketing campaigns, development of tourism assets, and promoting Queensland as a tourism destination. Tourism Queensland is a registered trading name of Tourism and Events Queensland Pty Ltd which is a public limited by guarantee company. Executive Tourism Queensland executive is responsible for running the day-to-day operations of the organisation, and comprises a Chief Executive Officer and four executive officers: Keith Hearn is the Chief Executive Officer of Tourism Queensland. He was formerly the chief executive of the Australian Tourism Export Council, the national body representing the sector. Liz Watermeyer is the general manager of Queensland. Jim Yeomans is the tourism portfolio manager. Trish Flood is the tourism portfolio manager.
