* Photoshop Elements, designed as a more budget-oriented photo editor, is available for both Windows and Macintosh computers. * If you're interested in an inexpensive alternative to Photoshop, consider GraphicConverter, which includes many editing features, much like what you get with Photoshop Elements. * A program like Photoshop costs more than \$100, and for that price you're usually getting very good image-editing functionality. If you're a proficient photographer and image manipulator, you can probably get everything you need from your camera and a little practice. Sometimes you may want to apply text to an image in Photoshop. This is tricky, but it's not as hard as it sounds. The most basic approach is to place text directly on an image and then try to position it. If it looks awkward, it probably is — especially if you want to use the text as a layer style. You can add text to an image in Photoshop by using the Text tool. You can place the text anywhere on the image you want, and then you can increase or decrease the text size by using the Size box in the Tool Options area. The typeface can be changed, and the font size and color can be modified, depending on your preference. You may need to crop the text into a specific shape to make it fit in the image. Sometimes you have to hide some parts of the text — for example, when you put a headline over an image of a person. Photos taken using digital cameras typically have a white or black background, but sometimes they may be taken in a blue or green background, for example. If you're photographing your subject in an outdoor environment or in a studio, you may have the background in front of you, and that's a problem. You can remove or replace the background by using the Background Eraser (Selecting an Area) and Background flattening tools (Chapter 13) or by using Photoshop layers (Chapter 4). You can also use the Photoshop Text tool to add text to an image. You select the text tool (View → Type → Type Tool) and then click and drag to create a text box on the image. When you're finished, you can group the box and layer it. As you move the mouse cursor over the background of an image, you may notice that it changes color. This is the style, or colorization, applied to the layer. Colorization can be a subtle tool, or it can be used

Questions Facing a Player Following Tommy John Surgery 1/20/2009 If a player has major league experience and recently had Tommy John surgery, does the team use the opportunity to bring him back after the season or let him become a free agent? Possibly, but not guaranteed. In fact, a number of Tommy John surgery patients are signed as free agents, but they're often not the best choices. This is due to a combination of technical reasons and the fact that those players will be required to pass the physical. Some players who have had Tommy John surgery are not in condition to do so, although Major League Baseball will usually make a player whose arm is deemed "untouchable" once he's had Tommy John surgery. However, the exact reason a team would want to bring a player back after Tommy John surgery is not always certain. So the first step is to evaluate the player and determine whether the team should sign him or let him become a free agent. Wendy and I have also been debating this very question. It seems that the desire is for the players to be completely healthy and prepared. One of the questions we've thought about is the fact that many organizations, including Major League Baseball, are reluctant to offer surgery insurance, which means that if a player has Tommy John surgery during a season when his contract is guaranteed, he will not be paid for the season. Some players have insurance, and some do not, and the choice is often based on the player's playing ability. If an organization is financially comfortable with the idea of having no insurance, it may be more willing to sign a player coming off Tommy John surgery because of the player's ability, regardless of whether he's had the surgery or not. Another question is this: If a player has a disability that prevents him from playing baseball, does the team have any obligation to permit him to work as a coach or manager? For example, if the pitcher had an injury to his arm and had surgery, but is now preparing to return to the mound, is the team obligated to allow him to try to be a coach or manager? In our experience, organizations are willing to allow players, especially minor leaguers, to
